



SASKATCHEWAN MARSHALS SERVICE (SMS)

What is the SMS and its mandate?

- A specialized <u>provincial</u> police service designed to:
 - Focus on provincial priorities.
 - Detect, disrupt and deter criminal activity.
 - Enforce provincial and federal law.
 - Apprehend high risk and prolific offenders and wanted individuals.
 - Conduct proactive investigations related to gangs, illegal weapons, drugs and agricultural crimes such as cattle theft and more.
 - Provide specialized support to other law enforcement in the province.
 - Enhance police presence in the province with a specific focus in rural and remote communities.

What is the SMS and its mandate?

- Able to respond to emergent and urgent events anywhere in the province (such as the James Smith Cree Nation Incident).
- Able to provide enhanced presence in "hot spot areas."
- Aid other law enforcement or police services for no cost (unless extreme cases).



What it is not!

- A replacement for any police service of jurisdiction (POJ).
- Designed to provide core policing functions (911 response).
- Designed to operate in a cost recovery model.



The Benefits - SMS Integration and Partnership

- Enhance presence and capacity throughout the province.
- Force multiplier for police services or law enforcement.
- Increased focus and targeting of the priorities of the province.
- Enhance intelligence sharing (CISS/WIT/LE).



The Organization

- The Chief of Police is known as the Chief Marshal
 - Deputy Chief Marshal
 - Superintendents
 - Inspectors
 - Marshals
- Enforcement Branch
 - 70 police officers (including the Chief)
- Operational Support Service Branch
 - 30 support positions
- \$20 Million budget



The Organization

- First district HQ in Prince Albert
- Multiple field offices to be developed
 - Determined based on intelligence and data including crime trends, CSI, calls for service and other factors.



The Organization

- Expected to be operational by 2026 (or sooner).
- Recruitment
 - Phase 1 Experienced Police Officers
 - Phase 2 New Entries (Recruits)
- Training
 - 10-week Marshals Basic Training (MBT) All EPO's
 - New Entries will complete basic recruit training at SK Police College (21-week program)
