Dear SSGA Board of Directors,

On behalf of the Saskatchewan Cattle Association (SCA) Board of Directors, we thank you for your request for us to address two specific resolutions put forward by your membership at your semi-annual meeting.

Specifically, you requested response to the following resolutions:

Resolution #16

WHEREAS the Saskatchewan Cattle Association has been discussing the discontinuation of their fall district meetings due to poor attendance.

BE IT RESOLVED that SSGA lobby the SCA to continue to engage cattle producers by holding annual district meetings and consider holding the meetings at a better time of year for cattle producers.

Resolution #17

WHEREAS the transition to e-manifests is slow to take shape and be implemented; and
WHEREAS manifests are an important part of our internal provincial traceability without CFIA involvement.

BE IT RESOLVED that SSGA lobby SCA, LSS and the Government of Saskatchewan to expedite this process without extra cost to producers as this benefits the whole industry.

In response to *Resolution #16*, I want to assure you that SCA remains committed to creating every opportunity to engage with Saskatchewan producers and provide various forums for producers to provide feedback and communicate with their organization and elected representatives. SCA has no intention of discontinuing our fall district meetings and will be hosting meetings in every district across Saskatchewan this fall in late September and early October.

In response to *Resolution #17*, the SCA recognizes and shares your acknowledgment of the importance of manifests in our provincial system and the desire to expedite the transition to e-manifests and make improvements for the whole industry assuring no extra cost to producers. We will continue to work with Livestock Services of Saskatchewan (LSS) to advance these improvements on behalf of Saskatchewan cattle producers.

We thank you for your ongoing collaboration and look forward to continuing to work with you to represent Saskatchewan beef cattle producers.
